

Soloist[®] Brevi Digital PC Comparative Recorder

Soloist Brevi is a simple, affordable, easy-to-use student software module. It is typically installed on each student's PC and works in tandem with the Sony Virtuoso™ Instructional Control Software, the teacher's digital interface and control panel. Both software components communicate via a local area network (LAN) connection. Together, the Sony Virtuoso Software and the Sony Soloist Brevi Software create a fully interactive language learning environment.



Sony Soloist Brevi Digital PC Comparative Recorder Software is a great tool to develop and enrich listening and speaking skills in the target language. This software component enables students to listen to an audio passage or view a video, speak and record their voice simultaneously. The original audio and student recording are saved to a single, standard format audio file. Students can review both audio tracks simultaneously to compare their speaking to the original program material.

- Set up to 50 bookmarks within a file to review or reinforce a particular segment
 - Add instructor comments
- Save student recordings to a "drop box" for later review by the instructor
- Synchronize text with audio and video files
